WAYS TO FAST

We encourage you to join us by doing one meal a day for 21 days.

There are other ways that you can fast:

Intermittent Fast until 6pm: You can pick a daily approach, which restricts daily eating to one six to eight hour period each day.

Dry Fast: A type of fasting that involves abstaining from food and liquids for an extended period of time.

Fruits, Veggies & Water: A type of partial fast that focuses very heavily on vegetables, fruits and water.

Water Only: A regular fast is when you abstain from all food and drink except for water.

WHAT IS FASTING?

Fasting is a deliberate period where we abstain from food to focus on spiritual communion with God through prayer. In the New Testament, fasting was practiced to minister to God, ordain individuals into ministry, and seek God's guidance during times of crisis. It's essential to always have a clear purpose when fasting.

Take the example of Daniel, who fasted for 21 days by abstaining from "pleasant bread" (Dan. 10:3). There are various approaches to fasting, with flexibility rather than rigid rules. Daniel's fasting involved disciplined eating rather than total abstinence, illustrating the control of one's physical desires.

Fasting doesn't change God, as He remains consistent regardless of our fasting. However, fasting **CHANGES US!** We become more sensitive to the Holy Spirit. Preparation for fasting can involve studying scriptures like Nehemiah 9:1-5 (returning to God), Esther 4:12-17 (seeking God's help), and others, to align oneself spiritually before fasting.
